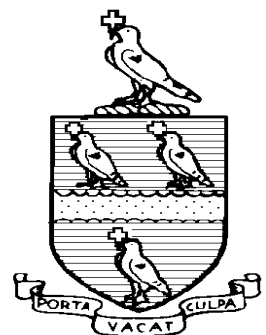

In 2010, Repton School Enterprises will run two cricket courses, one at Easter and one in summer, to assist young cricketers improve their skills and technique and motivate them in their sports development.

Easter Cricket (Wed 7th—Fri 9th April)

Our Easter Cricket courses have helped young cricketers to get the season off to a flying start for more than a decade. Each day (10am—4pm) comprises a mix of activities and practices in batting, bowling, fielding and wicket keeping to give our students a better understanding of cricket and improve their skills. Mike Stones, ECB Level 2 coach and coach educator and former Staff and Advanced Coach to the National Cricket Association, will lead the team and coach throughout the course.

Who Should Attend?

The course is aimed at boys and girls, aged 10—15, of all standards.



What do we need to bring?

If you've got your own kit, please bring it as it is better to use your own equipment—you will also need to bring a (hard) cricket ball. However, we have kit to lend you if you need some. You should wear sports clothing (you are welcome to wear cricket whites but they're not crucial). Students should bring a packed lunch each day—squash and water will be provided at all breaks.

What facilities will be used?

The course is based in the Repton School Sports Centre where 3 cricket nets are available. As numbers are limited places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

How do I book?

Please read "Terms and Conditions" below **and overleaf** then complete and return the booking form opposite and send it to Repton Enterprises with payment (see Terms and Conditions clauses 1 and 10). Your booking will be confirmed immediately and final joining instructions sent two weeks before the course starts.

Cost : £95 (less early payment discount of £5 if applicable—see clause 10 overleaf)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BOTH COURSES (continued over)

- 1. A deposit of £50 is required to book your place unless you take advantage of the Early Payment Discount (see Clause 10). Where not benefitting from the discount the final balance is due not later than 28 days prior to the course start date.*
- 2. Cancellation of your booking within 14 working days of the commencement of the course will result in the loss of your fee.*
- 3. Your child may be excluded from the course if, in our opinion, his/her presence is detrimental to the happiness or well being of other students, in which case no refund will be given.*

Summer Cricket (Monday 26th – Friday 30th July)

For the first time, Repton School and Derbyshire Cricket Board have teamed up to provide a high quality cricket course this summer. The combination of Derbyshire Cricket Board's experience and coaching expertise in developing young cricketers and Repton's superb facilities will give you the perfect opportunity to improve your game.



The course is appropriate for 7 – 14 year old cricketers, boys and girls, from complete beginners onwards and aims to give them the basics and/or improve their technique and ability. Headed by at least an ECB Level 3 coach, we shall cover the practical skills of batting, bowling, fielding and wicket-keeping as well as learning about cricket tactics.

Each day begins at 9 am, has a lunch break and ends at 4 pm. If students have cricket kit of their own, we recommend they bring it but loan equipment will be available if needed. Students should bring a packed lunch and drinks each day



What facilities will be used?

Coaching will take place on the school's top quality cricket pitches and outdoor cricket nets. Wet weather contingency plans are in place if the weather is bad.

How do I book?

Please complete and return the booking form inside the front cover and send it with payment (see Terms and Conditions clauses 1 and 10). Your booking will be confirmed immediately and final joining instructions sent two weeks before the course starts.

Cost : £145 (less early payment discount of £10 if applicable—see clause 10 below)

5. If RSE Ltd has to cancel the course we will reimburse any monies you have paid.
6. You will be asked to complete a Consent and Medical form before the course starts. This is to ensure we are able to handle any emergencies involving your child during the course.
7. If your child requires any medication whilst on the course you agree to inform a designated member of staff on arrival.
8. If your child shows any signs of being unwell whilst at Repton School, RSE Ltd staff will notify the emergency contact named on the Consent and Medical form.
9. All equipment, clothing and other property brought to Repton must be marked clearly with your child's name.
