Repton Enterprises Summer Hockey Courses are now well established in the hockey calendar—we will again run two three-day hockey courses in 2011. The “Elite Hockey Academy”, an intensive, short, residential course for elite or aspiring elite players and the “Repton Hockey Course”, a non-residential course for local school and club players (see over).

Elite Hockey Academy (Sun 21st - Tues 23rd Aug) **Course Director—Martin Jones**

Repton School’s Director of Hockey Martin Jones won 115 International Caps for England and Great Britain. He was English Premier League Player of the Season in 2005 and is now player-coach of Beeston HC who play in the European Hockey League.



Repton has an impressive record of success in the National School Hockey Finals. Repton U18 girls are National Champions having won an Indoor or Outdoor title for each of the last seven years. The U18 boys and U14 girls are also reigning National Schools Champions. The current school hockey teams boast nine players with International experience and many others are regularly involved in Junior Regional Performance Centres

This elite course provides intensive training by International players to 11 – 16 year old hockey players (boys and girls) who have reached, or aspire to reach, County hockey standard or higher.

Camp features

- Advanced stick skill coaching
 - Specialist goal-scoring sessions
 - First-class boarding facilities
 - Comprehensive evening activities
- All training on the Olympic standard water-based pitch
 - Coaching of International standard tactics and techniques
 - Small sided game-play to further develop skills
 - Advice and education on sports science issues such as nutrition and physiological development
 - Learn how to exploit the recently introduced 'self pass' rule



Cost - £280 inclusive of accommodation, all meals, coaching etc

Places are limited though so do book early to avoid disappointment.

Repton Hockey Course (Wed 24th – Fri 26th August)

Course Director—Simon Clague

Our popular, non-residential hockey course will also take place at Repton's superb facilities. Its August timing will ensure that students are well prepared for the new hockey season starting in September.



The course is appropriate for 10 – 14 year old hockey players (boys and girls) from complete beginners onwards aiming to give them the basics and/or improve their technique and/or ability, possibly with the view to playing at school, club or junior county level in the immediate future.

Each day begins at 9 am, has a break for lunch, and ends at 4 pm. Students should bring their own packed lunch. Players are also asked to bring their own stick, gum-shield and shin pads. Advice will be given where necessary regarding equipment.



The course will provide coaching in all aspects of the game and is led by Simon Clague, former Wales International and Repton's Master in Charge of Hockey for the last 20 years. Like Martin, Simon is a key part of the coaching team which has brought Repton to such prominence in youth hockey. Simon will be supported by a team of young coaches who have progressed through the school's hockey system.

Cost - £123. Attendees should bring a packed lunch each day

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BOTH COURSES

- 1. A deposit of £50 is required to book your place unless you take advantage of the Early Payment Discount (see Clause 10). Where not benefitting from the discount the final balance is due not later than 28 days prior to the course start date.*
- 2. Cancellation of your booking within 14 working days of the commencement of the course will result in the loss of your fee.*
- 3. Your child may be excluded from the course if, in our opinion, their presence is detrimental to the happiness or well being of other students, in which case no refund will be given.*
- 4. RSE Ltd accepts no responsibility for injury or damage to persons or property.*
- 5. If RSE Ltd has to cancel the course we will reimburse any monies you have paid.*
- 6. You will be asked to complete a Consent and Medical form before the course starts. This is to ensure we are able to handle any emergencies involving your child during the course.*
- 7. If your child requires any medication whilst on the course you agree to inform a designated member of staff on arrival.*
- 8. If your child shows any signs of being unwell whilst at Repton School, RSE Ltd staff will notify the emergency contact named on the Consent and Medical form.*
- 9. All equipment, clothing and other property brought to Repton must be marked clearly with your child's name.*
- 10. Discount—in recognition of our reduced admin costs where bookings are made and paid for in full in advance, an Early Payment Discount of 10% may be deducted off the course fee by those who **book and pay in full** by 1st July 2011.*
